Pursuant to the Section 155 of the Michigan Drain Code, any owner of land within the drainage district or any city, village, township, district, or county feeling aggrieved by the Apportionment of Benefits made by the Drain Commissioner, may appeal the apportionment within ten(10) days after the Day of Review of Apportionment by making an application to the Lenawee County Probate Court for the appointment of a board of review.
