

HERVEY TILE DRAIN

Established January, 1900

DRAINAGE DISTRICT: Adrian Township sections 19,20,29,30

BRIEF HISTORY OF DRAIN: Last assessment was in 2000 for \$2,500.00 for maintenance. No previous petitions have been received.

CURRENT ACTION: A petition was returned on September 9, 2003 from the Lenawee County Road Commission along with a Road Commission Board Resolution requesting cleaning out, relocating, widening, deepening, straightening, tiling, enlarging, extending or relocating along a highway and a study to investigate drainage and flooding problems occurring along the Hervey Tile Drain and within the Hervey Tile Drain Drainage District and implementation of improvements to the drain for relief; commencing at a point located approximately 860 ft. North of the center 1/4 post, Section 29 Adrian Township (T-6-S, R-3-E), thence proceeding across Section 29 through Hunt Rd. across Section 20, through Hunt Rd., across Section 29 to terminus, according to survey by F.S. Phillips dated January 23, 1900, or to another point determined to provide adequate drainage of such drain is necessary and conducive to the public health, convenience or welfare of the Township of Adrian.

Petition was signed by Orrin Gregg, Managing Director of the Lenawee County Road Commission and was accompanied by a Road Commission Board Resolution signed by Commissioner Merrill Bales, Commissioner Phil Hart, Commissioner Don Isley.

CURRENT BALANCE: \$1,328.80 in the drain fund prior to any expenses connected with this petition.

TOTAL LENGTH OF DRAIN: 4092 Feet
