The Michigan Department of Environmental Quality proposes to reissue a discharge permit for a wastewater discharge to the ground or groundwater pursuant to Rule 2218 of the Part 22 Rules of Part 31, Water Resources Protection, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451) being Sections 324.3101 through 324.3119 of the Compiled Laws of Michigan, and the administrative rules promulgated there under, to:

The applicant proposes to discharge a maximum 850,000 gallons per day (48,000,000 gallons per year) of sanitary sewage wastewater only to the ground and groundwater from their discharge areas located in Cambridge Township, Lenawee County. The wastewater treatment plant consists of an aerated lagoon system followed by spray irrigation.

Comments or objections to the proposed authorization received by May 26, 2011, will be considered in the final decision to grant the authorization.
